Patron:

- Annual notice is mailed in April of each year
- Update Membership profile by May 15th
- Pay annual dues by May 15th of each year
- Late fee will be applied after May 15th
- Submit dues to the P. O. Box listed below
- May put up potential new members each year
- Have voting privileges
- Receives 4 seats to the ball
- Serve for 4 years on the Board (starting 2016)
- Financial commitment of 10 years
- 7 years of Charity Ball service
 - Years 1-4 = set up/work the Ball
 - Years 5-7 = work French Picnic or New Member party

Sustainer:

- Annual notice is mailed in April of each year
- Update Membership profile by May 15th
- Pays annual dues by May 15th each year
- Late fee will be applied after May 15th
- Submit dues to the P. O. Box listed below
- May put up potential new members or daughter
- No voting privileges
- Receives 4 seats to the ball
- Completed 10 year Patron financial commitment
- Completed 7 years of Charity Ball service
- Completed 4 years of Charity Ball Board positions (4 starting in 2016)

Debutante Fee:

- Debutante fee is due with a written letter of acceptance of presentation by January 15th
- Debutante fee due January 15th in full or second installment due July 15th plus annual dues by May 15th

Sustainer presenting a granddaughter:

- Need to reinstate 5 years before to present your granddaughter
 - Ex. (2016, 2017, 2018, 2019 to Present 2020)
- Pay Deb Fee by January 15th in full or second installment due July 15th plus Patron dues by May 15. Patron dues for the 4 years prior to presentation due May 15th.
- Presentation year: Pay Sustainer dues by May 15th

Membership Reminders:

- There are no more than 100 Patron members
- Patron must live within an 85-mile radius of Baton Rouge
- Cannot be presented by another debutante organization with in the 85-mile radius of Baton Rouge, or before being presented by Charity Ball
- High school and under are not allowed at the ball unless it is a sibling of a debutante but must leave after the presentation
